As part of our Computing Curriculum, we teach all children at Eastfield about how to keep themselves safe online. This is an area that is very important to our school and pupils. That's why, starting on 6th February, we will be having a special, week long focus on internet and technology safety.

In the UK, Safer Internet Day is organised by the UK Safer Internet Centre (www.saferinternet.org.uk), and this year's theme is "Be the change: unite for a better internet." Childnet International, who form part of the UK Safer Internet Centre have produced an online safety presentation to help schools, parents and carers, support children and young people online.

To celebrate the many positives of the internet, and to raise awareness of the issues that children and young people face online today, we will be hosting an online safety information session for parents and carers of children in every year group to deliver this presentation. The session will provide practical advice and safety tips to help manage online safety issues, and discussions surrounding suitable behaviour online.
